## **Comité Hispano Report**

January 2011

Since our last report to the Parish Council in October 2010 the Comité Hispano and the Hispanic community of St. Augustine's Parish have completed some projects that we had already begun or planned and have begun plans for this new year 2011.

The coordinators of many ministries completed the course of workshops offered by the Catholic Diocese of Richmond. They will be a wonderful resource as leaders for our community and for our Diocese.

We have participated in the Posadas during Advent and this year we had a new Advent activity, the Adviento Misionero. This activity is a way of taking the Gospel of Jesus Christ into the homes of our parishioners during Advent.

The Dinner for those involved in Parish ministries was held on December 30 and was attended by a large number of parishioners involved in all types of ministries. We were entertained by a DJ and enjoyed a wonderful dinner prepared by members of our parish. Afterward each person who had participated in parish ministry received a token gift of appreciation.

We are still raising funds for Renaissance Revisited by holding food sales after Mass each month and by the contributions from the haircuts each Saturday morning.

The Hermandad del Señor de los Milagros has also contributed to the Renaissance building fund the money collected at the Mass offered in October in honor of El Señor de los Milagros (The Lord of Miracles) This popular devotion which had its beginning in Peru has found a new home at St. Augustine's and the image has been installed in the chapel.

Every month we have a Spiritual Formation Program with a different theme each month developed by members of one or more ministries. The themes were suggested by the parish at large.

We are still adding new parishioners each month. We have had many baptisms. Our RCIA and marriage ministries are very busy.

Our Comite has many new members this year since many ministries have had discernments and have new coordinators. We look forward to a very interesting and fruitful year.
