

## **List of activities to do (or continue to do) with your family as we await the beginning of L.I.F.E. and beyond:**

Attend mass on a regular basis.

Use any money that you may have spent for religious education fees this year to purchase a subscription to “*Catholic Parent*”, “*U.S. Catholic*” or another helpful resource.

Purchase a Catholic bible if you do not own one.

Spend time together with your family when you would have been out on a Sunday, Monday or Tuesday night for religious education. Eat dinner together, read to each other, spend time helping others together.

Participate in additional outreach efforts during the year – send in money for our new CFCA child - Noel, volunteer in our Food Pantry on Saturday mornings, help serve breakfast or clean up at our Poor Box breakfast once a month, help with CARITAS in February, visit our local nursing homes once a month and make inexpensive cards or gifts to share with the residents when you visit, spend time outside with your children enjoying the beauty of God’s creation and caring for it at the same time (Adopt a Highway, Buildings and Grounds, etc.).

Work on all the basic Catholic prayers with your children and youth. Not only the ones we say at mass but all others – meal blessings, the Confiteor, praying the Rosary to name a few. (*All prayers are located in the back of your child’s textbook from last year. If you need a copy of all the prayers, please contact the office.*)
